<u>PFT</u>	CG Group Portland Division may conduct PFTs this drill weekend. All Cadets needing to pass the PFT are expected to participate and must bring PT gear including regulation shorts, shirt, socks and running shoes. <i>ALL Cadets must pass the PFT in order to attend advanced trainings.</i>

Meals (\$20.00)	All Hands are required to give 5-day notice of absence from drill weekend. As attendance is called into the Coast Guard Station for meals, failure to do so will result in paying for meals.
Dues (\$10.00)	Dues must be paid for all drills – present or absent – no excuses.
